An Act to revive The Noble House Corporation

Preamble

James Noble has applied for special legislation to revive The Noble House Corporation. The applicant represents that he was the president, secretary and sole director of the corporation when it was dissolved. The corporation was voluntarily dissolved under the *Business Corporations Act* on April 22, 2014 pursuant to articles of dissolution. The applicant represents that he would like to revive the corporation in order to deal with certain property held in the corporation's name at the time of dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

Corporation revived

1 The Noble House Corporation is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.

Commencement

2 This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.

Short title

3 The short title of this Act is *The Noble House Corporation Act, 2023*.
