The Standing Committee on Public Accounts met on Wednesday, April 6, 2011 to hear from senior Ministry of Transportation officials on the Auditor General's follow-up report on the Commercial Vehicle Safety and Enforcement Program (Sec. 4.05 of the Auditor General's 2010 Annual Report). Ministry officials informed the Committee about Ministry progress in addressing the Auditor's 10 recommendations on:

- registration of commercial vehicle operators;
- coordination of roadside inspection resources;
- bus inspections;
- vehicles with defects;
- the roadside inspection capture system;
- intervention activities such as the accuracy of safety ratings, out-of-province events and red light cameras;
- high-risk operators, facility audits, leased vehicles and the new entrant program;
- motor vehicle inspection stations;
- safety education; and
- road safety measurement and reporting.
