Ms. Peggy Sattler: I would also like to express my opposition to this motion. This is a public committee of the Legislature. The Legislature should be as transparent as possible in the way that we conduct the people's business. There were many comments made during the debate on this legislation about the importance of getting it to committee. The process of determining how the committee is going to proceed should also be open to the public. So I am opposed to this motion.
