That this afternoon's debate be considered one full sessional day of debate on the motion for Second Reading of Bill 43, An Act to protect existing and future sources of drinking water and to make complementary and other amendments to other Acts, which debate shall be adjourned by the Speaker at 6:00 p.m.

At 6:00 p.m., the Acting Speaker declared the debate on the motion for Second Reading of Bill 43 to be adjourned.

Debate was resumed on the motion for Second Reading of Bill 78, An Act to amend the Education Act, the Ontario College of Teachers Act, 1996 and certain other statutes relating to education.
