Certain members, having taken the Oath of Allegiance, took their seats in the Legislative Chamber.

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor entered the Chamber and took his seat upon the Throne.

The Government House Leader said:-

“I am commanded by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor to state that he does not see fit to declare the causes of the summoning of the present legislature of this Province until a Speaker of this House shall have been chosen according to law, but tomorrow at 2:00 p.m. His Honour will declare the causes of the calling of this Legislature.”

His Honour was then pleased to retire.

The Clerk of the Legislative Assembly addressed the Members as follows:-

“Members of the Legislative Assembly, it is my duty to call upon you to elect one of your numbers to preside over your deliberations as Speaker, therefore, I ask for nominations for the Office of the Speaker.”

Mr. Arnott moved, seconded by Ms. Jones, That Mr. Nicholls, member for the Electoral District of Chatham–Kent–Essex, do take the Chair of this House as Speaker.

M<sup>me</sup> Gélinas moved, seconded by Mr. Hatfield, That Mr. Miller, member for the Electoral District of Hamilton East–Stoney Creek, do take the Chair of this House as Speaker.

Mrs. Albanese moved, seconded by Mr. Berardinetti, That Mr. Qaadri, member for the Electoral District of Etobicoke North, do take the Chair of this House as Speaker.

Ms. Wong moved, seconded by Mr. Delaney, That Mr. Levac, member for the Electoral District of Brant, do take the Chair of this House as Speaker.

Mr. Tabuns moved, seconded by Ms. Armstrong, That Ms. DiNovo, member for the Electoral District of Parkdale–High Park, do take the Chair of this House as Speaker.

There being no further nominations, the Clerk declared the nominations closed.

And the election process having ensued, after some time, it was,

Resolved, That Mr. Levac do take the Chair of this House as Speaker.

The Clerk having declared the Honourable Mr. Levac duly elected, he was conducted by Ms. Wong and Mr. Delaney to the dais, where, standing on the upper step of the dais, he returned his humble acknowledgement to the House for the great honour that had been conferred on him by the members choosing him to be their Speaker.

The Speaker assumed the Chair and the Mace was laid upon the Table.
