M^{me} Lalonde moved,

M^{me} Lalonde propose,

That, pursuant to Standing Order 47 and notwithstanding any other Standing Order or Special Order of the House relating to Bill 177, An Act to implement Budget measures and to enact and amend various statutes, when the Bill is next called as a Government Order, the Speaker shall put every question necessary to dispose of the Second Reading stage of the Bill without further debate or amendment and at such time the Bill shall be ordered referred to the Standing Committee on Finance and Economic Affairs; and

That the Standing Committee on Finance and Economic Affairs be authorized to meet on Thursday, December 7, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:15 a.m. and from 1:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the purpose of public hearings on the Bill; and

That the Clerk of the Committee, in consultation with the Committee Chair, be authorized to arrange the notice of public hearings; and

That the deadline for requests to appear be 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, December 5, 2017; and

That if not all requests can be scheduled that the Clerk of the Committee provide the Members of the Subcommittee and their designates with the list of requests to appear by 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 5, 2017; and

That the Members of the Subcommittee and/or their designates prioritize and return the list to the Clerk of the Committee by 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 5, 2017; and

That the Clerk of the Committee distribute a draft copy of the agenda to the Committee members and their designates by Tuesday, December 5, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. and Wednesday, December 6, 2017 at 11:30 a.m.; and

That each witness will receive up to 5 minutes for their presentation followed by 9 minutes for questions, split evenly amongst the three recognized parties; and

That the deadline for written submissions be 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 7, 2017; and

That the deadline for filing amendments to the Bill with the Clerk of the Committee shall be 10:00 a.m. on Friday, December 8, 2017; and

That the Committee be authorized to meet on Monday, December 11, 2017 from 1:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., for the purpose of clause-by-clause consideration of the Bill; and

On Monday, December 11, 2017 at 4:30 p.m., those amendments which have not yet been moved shall be deemed to have been moved, and the Chair of the Committee shall interrupt the proceedings and shall, without further debate or amendment, put every question necessary to dispose of all remaining sections of the Bill and any amendments thereto. At this time, the Chair shall allow one 20-minute waiting period pursuant to Standing Order 129(a); and

That the Committee shall report the Bill to the House no later than Tuesday, December 12, 2017. In the event that the Committee fails to report the Bill on that day, the Bill shall be deemed to be passed by the Committee and shall be deemed to be reported to and received by the House; and

That, upon receiving the report of the Standing Committee on Finance and Economic Affairs, the Speaker shall put the question for adoption of the report forthwith, and at such time the Bill shall be ordered for Third Reading, which Order may be called that same day; and

That, when the Order for Third Reading of the Bill is called, 1 hour of debate shall be allotted to the Third Reading stage of the Bill, apportioned equally among the recognized parties. At the end of this time, the Speaker shall interrupt the proceedings and shall put every question necessary to dispose of this stage of the Bill without further debate or amendment; and

That, notwithstanding Standing Order 81 (c), the Bill may be called more than once in the same sessional day; and

The votes on Second and Third Reading may be deferred pursuant to Standing Order 28(h); and

That, in the case of any division relating to any proceedings on the Bill, the division bell shall be limited to 5 minutes.
