That in the case of any division on any proceeding provided for in this motion, the division bells be limited to 5 minutes; and

That the House shall continue to meet beyond the normal hour of adjournment today if necessary; and

That when the House adjourns today it shall stand adjourned until April 14, 2020 at 1:00 p.m.
